The film will bring scandal and shame to Marianna, who, unknowingly, is the star of the film. She is a beautiful, rather wild girl, who is poor and illiterate. She earns a meagre living by removing curses from people and curing the locals with herbs and potions.



LA PRIMA COSA BELLA

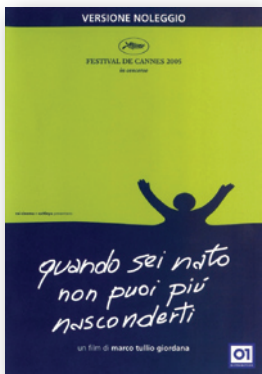

This is the story of the Michelucci family from the 1970's to the present day. The central character is the stunningly beautiful Anna, the lively, frivolous and sometimes embarrassing mother of Bruno and Valeria. It begins in the Summer of 1971, at the annual Summer beauty pageant held in Livorno. Anna is unexpectedly crowned “Most Beautiful Mother”, unwittingly stirring the violent jealousy of her husband. From then on, chaos strikes the family and for Anna, Bruno and his sister Valeria, it is the start of an adventure that only ends thirty years later. Bruno ends up living in Milan after managing to escape Livorno and his mother. He returns to his hometown at the end of the film to be at his mother's side during her last days.

Sandro is a young boy who is taken on holiday aboard a small sailing boat by his Father and Father's friend, Popi. One night, Sandro goes out on deck and falls over-board, without anyone knowing. He is lost at sea, however, Sandro is saved by an immigrant travelling aboard a large motor boat. The driver of the boat, is ferrying up to 100 immigrants from the border of eastern Europe to Italy. Sandro becomes friends with one of the immigrants, a Kurdish boy who speaks rough Italian. When they reach Italy his parents are informed of his whereabouts but Sandro wants to stay and to do everything he can for the people who have helped him.

Rachin, an egotistical disciplinarian whose mantra for the school is "action = reaction", which means that there will be severe consequences for any boy stepping out of line. This approach is not working as the boys are an unruly bunch. In turn, the teachers don't teach, as they are always watching out for the next subversive act from the boys. On the 15th January 1949 a new supervisor arrives. Monsieur Clément Mathieu, is a middle-aged man who is trying to find a place in life after a series of failed endeavours. Although he finds the boys unruly, Mathieu does not believe in the "action = reaction" policy, and as such, clashes with Rachin while secretly undermining the policy...
